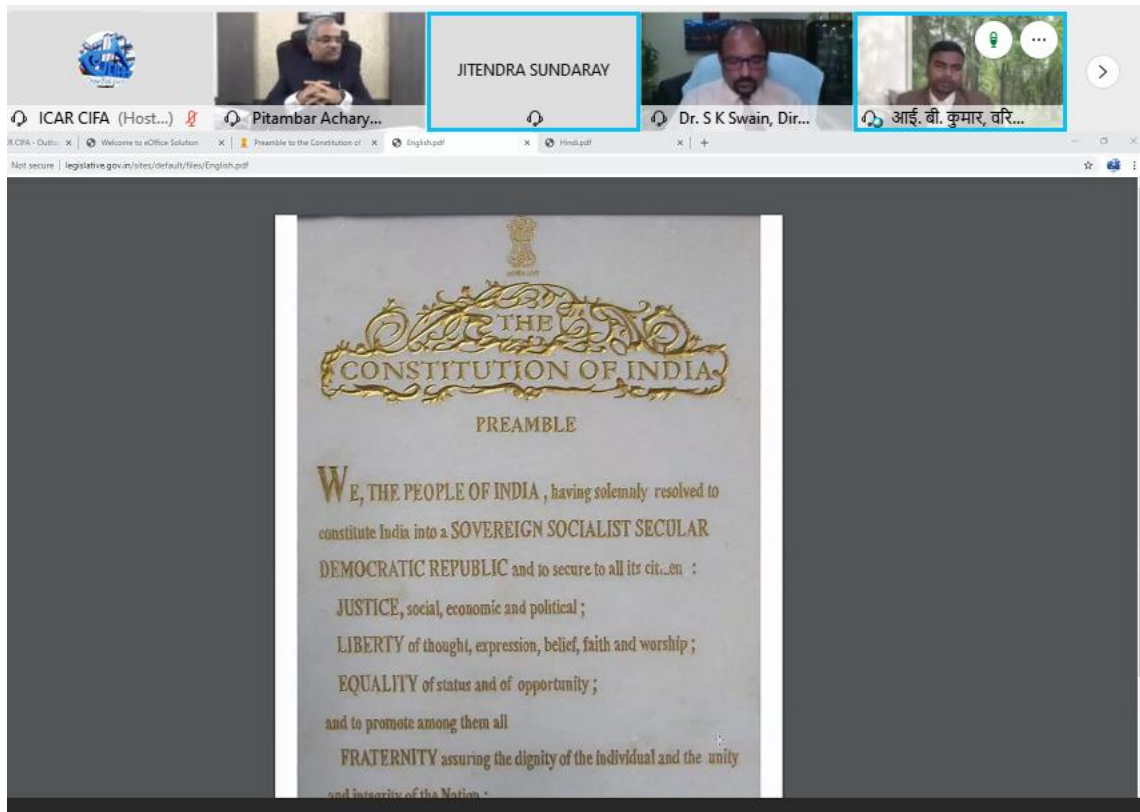


ICAR-CIFA observes Constitution Day
