Training Programme on “Fish Disease and Health Management in Freshwater Aquaculture”

Duration: 03-06 September, 2024

The Regional Research Centre, Rahara, ICAR-Central Institute of Freshwater Aquaculture successfully organized a four-day National Training Program on “Fish Disease and Health Management in Freshwater Aquaculture” during 03 - 06 September, 2024. Farmers, students, Entrepreneurs and Aquaculture technician from Andhra Pradesh, Maharashtra, Bihar, West Bengal, Mizoram and Haryana participated in the training programme. During inauguration Dr. B.N. Paul, Scientist-in-Charge welcomed the participants. In his opening remarks he had highlighted the importance of fish health and disease management in freshwater aquaculture for higher production. The training consisted of lectures, demonstration, and interaction sessions on emerging fish diseases, principles of fish health management, approved medicines and chemotherapeutants for use in aquaculture, concept of biosecurity, use of probiotics, principles of aquaculture, water and soil quality and fish feed. Dr. M. Samanta, Head, Fish Health Management Division virtually delivered a lecture on ‘Prospects of vaccines in aquaculture with special reference to ‘CIFA-Brood-Vac’. The participants were provided practical exposure to assessment of fish health, water and soil quality estimation, netting operation in ponds, hatchery operation and demonstration on farm-made feed formulation. A training manual was released and distributed among the participants. The participants were given certificates after successful completion of the programme. Dr. B.N. Paul and Dr. F. Hoque acted as the Course Director and the training program was co-ordinated by Dr. S. Adhikari, Dr. R. N. Mandal, Mr. A. Das, Dr. S. Sarkar and Mr A. Hussan.
