ICAR-CIFA organized 5-day training on “Recent Advances in Freshwater Aquaculture” during 08-12 January 2024 at RRC-Rahara, West Bengal

A 5-day training on “Recent Advances in Freshwater Aquaculture” was organized for B. F. Sc. Final year students of Neotia University, West Bengal during **08-12 January 2024** by ICAR-Central Institute of Freshwater Aquaculture at its Regional Research Centre, Rahara, West Bengal. During inauguration Dr. B.N. Paul, SIC and Course Director welcomed the students. In his opening remarks he told the students to take up scientific aquaculture as a career option and also motivated them to conduct higher studies and help the farmers to improve the fish production. The training consisted of lectures, demonstration, and interaction sessions on various aspects of freshwater aquaculture and the recent advancements. The students were exposed to different field activities such as netting of ponds, wastewater facility, hatchery operation etc. and hands on training was imparted on water quality management & fish pond fertilization, farm-made feed formulation and freshwater fish disease diagnosis. A total of twenty two students attended the training programme. The participants were given certificates after successful completion of the programme. Dr. B.N. Paul and Dr. F.
